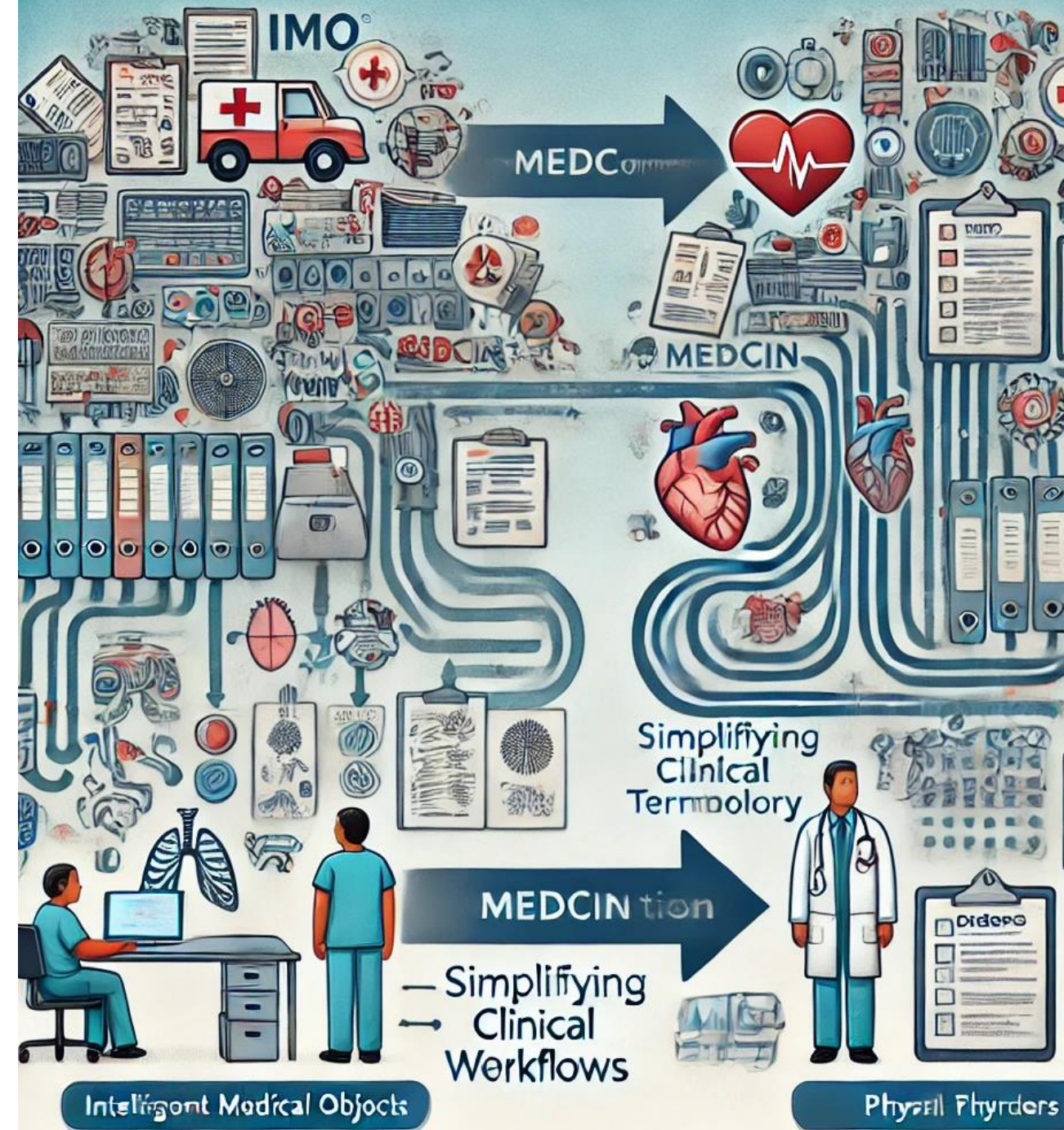

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# Conversion Process

- What are we missing?
- What should be different this time, ex HCC codes given priority

- Utilize the mappings data to convert both patient problem lists (instance) and admin build data
- Convert all problem-based admin data during upgrade
- Convert patient problem lists (instance) data
  - Job can be scheduled to run and the duration determined.
- Builds a 'Queue' of patients to convert
  - Patients with upcoming appointments (i.e. 7 days in the future)
  - Patients who are most frequently seen within the office (i.e. most number of encounters)
  - Patient Backlog
- Log all the patient problem list and build data that was converted for audit purposes

# Ad Hoc Conversion Dialog



Non-MEDCIN problems will need to manually “converted” by the user if problem is assessed



Former approach allowed user to map other items as well to aid in caring for patient who had not yet been converted and for unmapped problems



We are considering an ad-hoc wizard approach to aid in more efficient conversions for use cases where the patient’s problem have not yet been converted



What else would help ease the transition?

# FAQs

- **We had MEDCIN before, switch off was painful, now you're going back, will this happen again?**
  - We learned a lot from that experience and are committed to ensuring a smooth transition
  - As you saw from Bob Taylors demo we have substantially better tools
- **If MEDCIN is such a benefit, why did we switch in the first place?**
  - At the time Allscripts desired a single problem vendor across all products.
  - V11 note had moved away from structured use of the MEDCIN hierarchy; Allscripts had initially invested in MEDCIN in the early phased on v10 but had never extended or used the concepts as their full informational model
- **Is there an additional cost?**
  - Terminology costs are covered by your maintenance costs.
  - Overtime we will amend client contracts to eliminate direct vendor items such as IMO as we roll the same fees into your base maintenance. Simplified billing!
- **What release can we expect this change?**
  - the conversion and transition are planned for 2025.1 so clients taking 2025.1 and higher adopt medcin problem terminology, release vehicle to be finalized soon



# FAQs

- **Will this effect the current problems list and problem search functionality?**
  - With the initial release there will be some changes, such as the removal of the health maintenance problem placeholder (go head, cheer out loud!); ability to add problem terms that require additional information to generate a fully specified ICD code
  - Phased approach to problem list over 2025, be sure to attend our feature feedback sessions
- **How will this effect quality reporting?**
  - Low impact initially, improve long term
  - Problem value sets look to icd-10 and snomed terms, MEDCIN supports both; at minimum problems on our problem lists will require a snomed code
  - Converted problems are treated as “refined” TouchWorks, which means the problems details will persist when the linked problem entry is updated to the new term; this means metadata such as onset date, description, impression, etc will remain unchanged
- **How is this different than the v11.3 conversion?**
  - It is similar in that the conversion is required as we change terminology vendors; in 2012 the motivation was in support of the migration to ICD9 to ICD10.
  - In 2025 the conversion is motivated by the benefits of robust information model and the benefits Medicomp Quippe provides
