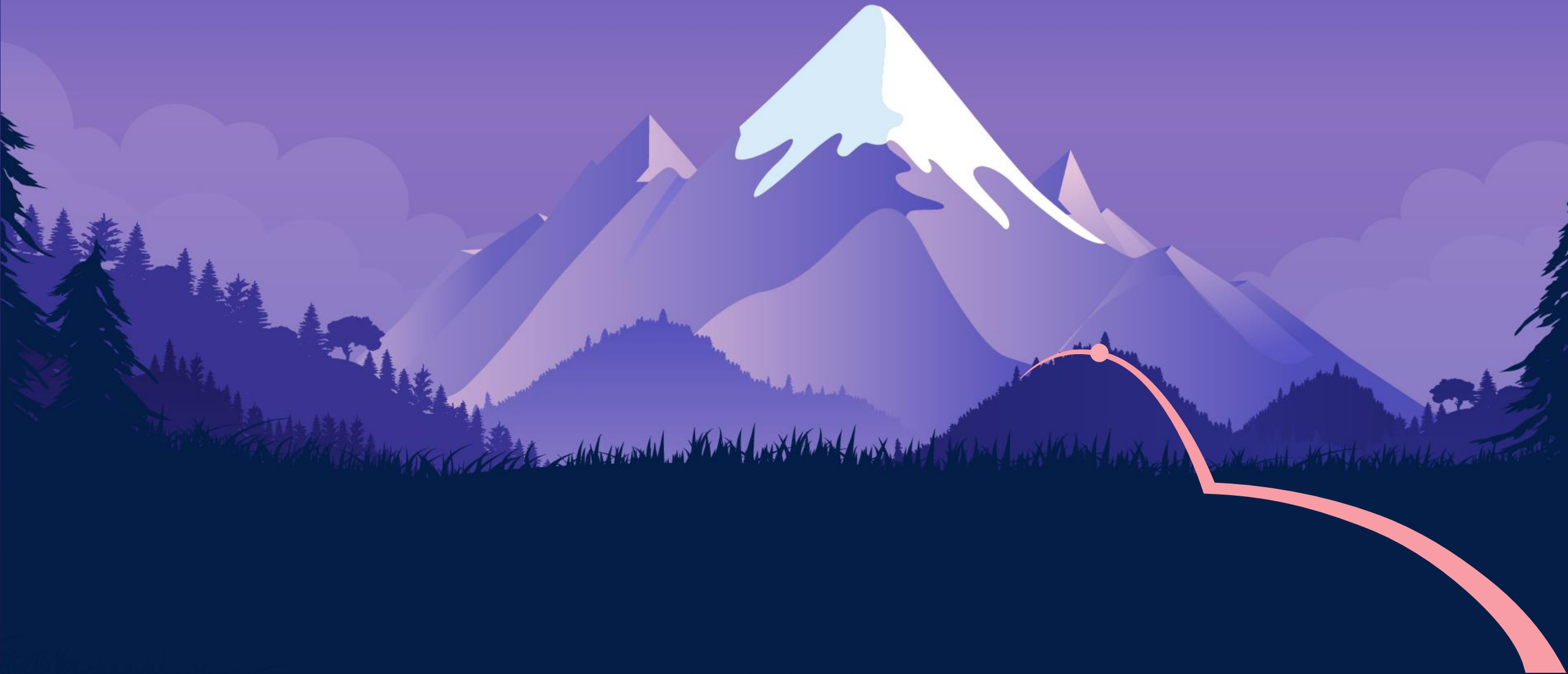

# TouchWorks 2024.3 – A quick reminder!

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## Performing for Promoting Interoperability?

- Must have upgraded to TouchWorks Version 2024.3 or higher (with FHIR R4 version 24.5 or higher) installed, by the first day of your 180-day performance period or no later than July 4, 2025

## Reporting on eQMs but not Promoting Interoperability?

- Must have upgraded to TouchWorks Version 2024.3 or higher (with FHIR R4 version 24.5 or higher) installed, by the last day of the performance period; no later than Dec 31, 2025

## ACO or Medicare Shared Savings Program Participants

- Verify **your CHERT requirement deadlines** with ACO Administrators.

# 2025 Quality Payment Program Final Rule Highlights

- Overall analysis – Traditional MIPS and MVP programs had minimal changes
- Many areas remained the same with no change:
  - Neutral adjustment threshold remains at 75 points
  - Eligible Clinician Type definitions
  - Minimum performance periods
  - Performance category weights
- Adopted minimum data submission criteria for each performance category
  - Quality – requires at least one measure that must include both a numerator and denominator
  - IA – requires at least one activity with a “yes” response
  - PI – all required elements for this category must be submitted



# 2025 Quality Payment Program Final Rule Highlights by Category

## ➤ Quality Category

- Complete removal of CMS 249 – Appropriate Use of DXA Scans in Women...
- Maintains data completeness criteria at 75% for 2025 and 2026 and extends it through 2027 and 2028 performance years
- Adds new APP Plus measure set for ACO and APM reporters; required for Shared Savings participants

## ➤ Improvement Activities

- Removes scoring weights of high and medium
- Instead, requires a specific number of activities to be submitted
  - Individuals and Groups submit 2 activities
  - Special statuses (small practice, rural, etc.) submit 1 activity
  - Submission of the above still equals 40 points or 100% category rate

## ➤ Promoting Interoperability Category

- No changes

# 2025 Quality Payment Program Final Rule Highlights

## ➤ MIPS Value Pathways

- No longer require participant to select one population health measure as part of the MVP registration process
- Improvement Activities - as with traditional MIPS, activity weights have been removed
  - Clinicians, groups and subgroups (regardless of special status) must attest to one activity
- 5 new MVP's added relevant to ambulatory clinicians
- 2 neurology-focused MVPs combined into a single neurological MVP
  - Quality Care for Patients with Neurological Conditions

## New MVPs added:

1. Complete Ophthalmologic Care
2. Gastroenterology Care
3. Optimal Care for Patients with Urologic Conditions
4. Dermatology Care
5. Pulmonology Care

*\*TouchWorks is assessing addition of the new MVP's into VCRS Dashboard*

# Promoting Interoperability Requirements Summary for 2025

## COLLECT DATA USING ONC HEALTH IT CERTIFIED VERSION

Deadline to be on applicable certified technology by the FIRST day of your 180-day reporting period

*New last "first" day to start is 07/05 of each year*

## CMS EHR CERTIFICATION NUMBER

## ACTIONS TO LIMIT OR RESTRICT INTEROPERABILITY OF CEHRT

Attest "yes"

## HIGH PRIORITY PRACTICES SAFER GUIDE

## SECURITY RISK ANALYSIS

Attest "yes" to having completed requirements within calendar year or by 12/31/25

## PERFORMANCE & REGISTRY MEASURES

Numerator/denominator measures require at least 1 count for each

Attestation measures must have a valid response or exclusion

# Electronic Case Reporting (eCR) – TouchWorks Update



The 2015 Cures Update Edition mandated the integration of automatic functionalities to facilitate the electronic sharing of health data related to specific diagnoses (trigger codes) with public health authorities.

Example: “Diagnosis = COVID”

- TouchWorks EHR must automatically send this predefined diagnosis information to the state's public health agency.
- States use the data for tracking diseases, taking necessary actions, and more.

## 5 Phases to achieve CDC Certification

- Phases 1 and 2; achieved ONC Certification, **done!**
- Phase 3, CDC Certification Testing, **done!**
- **We are here! Phase 4, BETA Testing w/Clients**
- Phase 5, “General Availability” (GA) and “Rollout”.

## Call Outs

- TouchWorks can only announce “GA” once passing CDC certification process.
- Slow testing response from the CDC has been escalated to CMS, CDC and ONC!

## Attestation Reminders for MIPS Promoting Interoperability performers,

- Current regulation requires advancement in 2025 to Option 2 active engagement: Validated Production
- Stay tuned for updates on this requirement!

- All 2025 date ranges & eCQM logic updates
- Reprocessing of all eCQM measures back to Jan 1, 2025
- Incorporation of 2025 historical benchmarks for MIPS Estimator Quality Dashboard scoring
- New quality measure badging for topped out vs capped measures
- Removal of CMS 249 – DXA Scan measure from PI and MIPS Quality Dashboards
- APP Plus - Addition of CMS 125 – Breast Cancer Screening to APM/ACO/APP Quality Dashboards

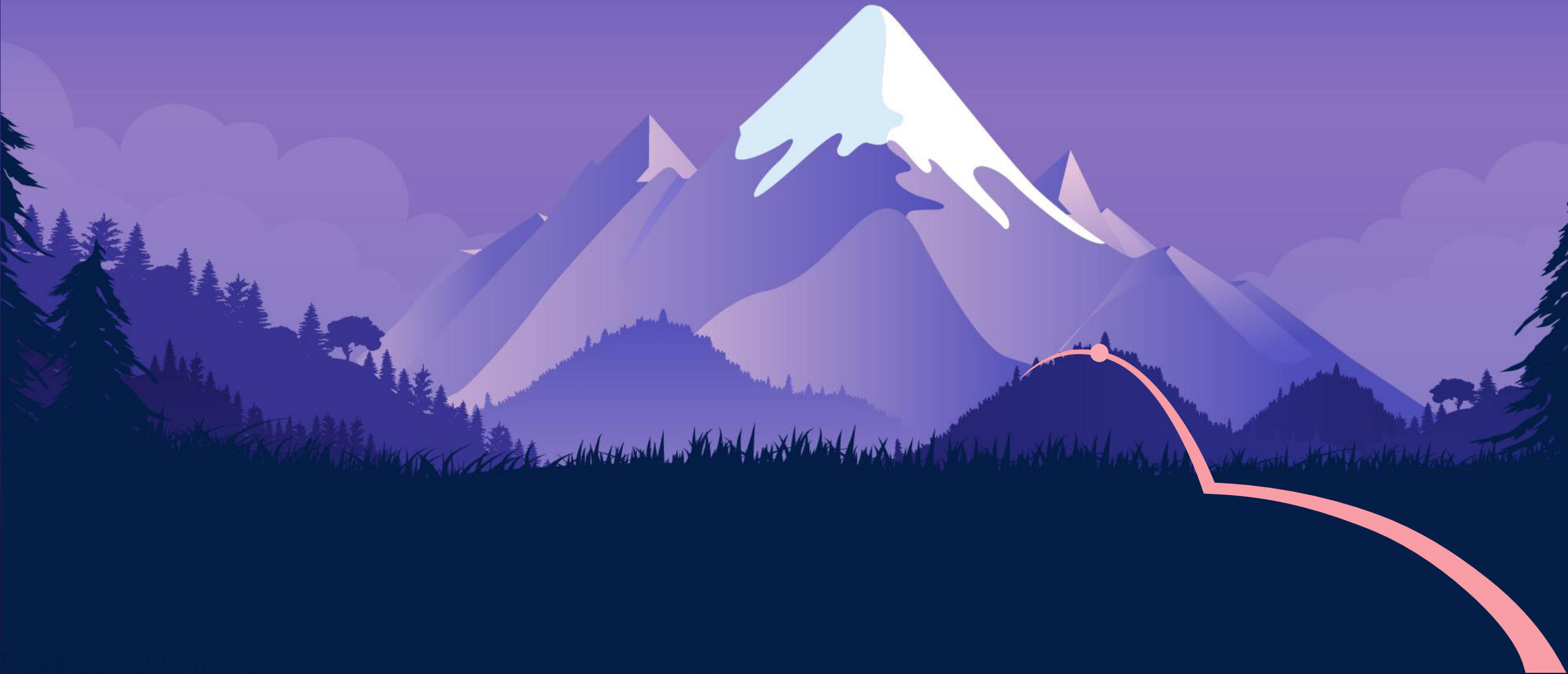

# FHIR and Endpoint Accessibility Monitoring

- **FHIR Publication and Endpoint Criteria**

- Must publish patient-facing FHIR endpoint in a standardized format (to ensure consistency across systems) – updates for needed changes met for Jan 1, 2025 deadline – **thank you!**
- Now we need to keep them updated and monitor patient endpoint accessibility
- TouchWorks created a proactive patient endpoint monitoring process
- FHIR License Management Portal (LMP) is the primary tool to manage and monitor FHIR publication content, such as your organization's name, ID numbers, address, contact information and R4 patient endpoint status



## Client's responsibility ... we are in this together!

- Actively monitor your FHIR R4 Endpoints. We all are equally responsible; Information Blocking.
- Verify your organization has a FHIR Endpoint monitoring process
- Includes receiving weekly License Management Portal (LMP) endpoint email alerts!
- If your organization's FHIR endpoint shows down and you need assistance to resolve, submit an Altera Support Case!



FHIR R4 endpoints are crucial to allow patients access to their own health information, the expectation is for your endpoint to always be accessible...

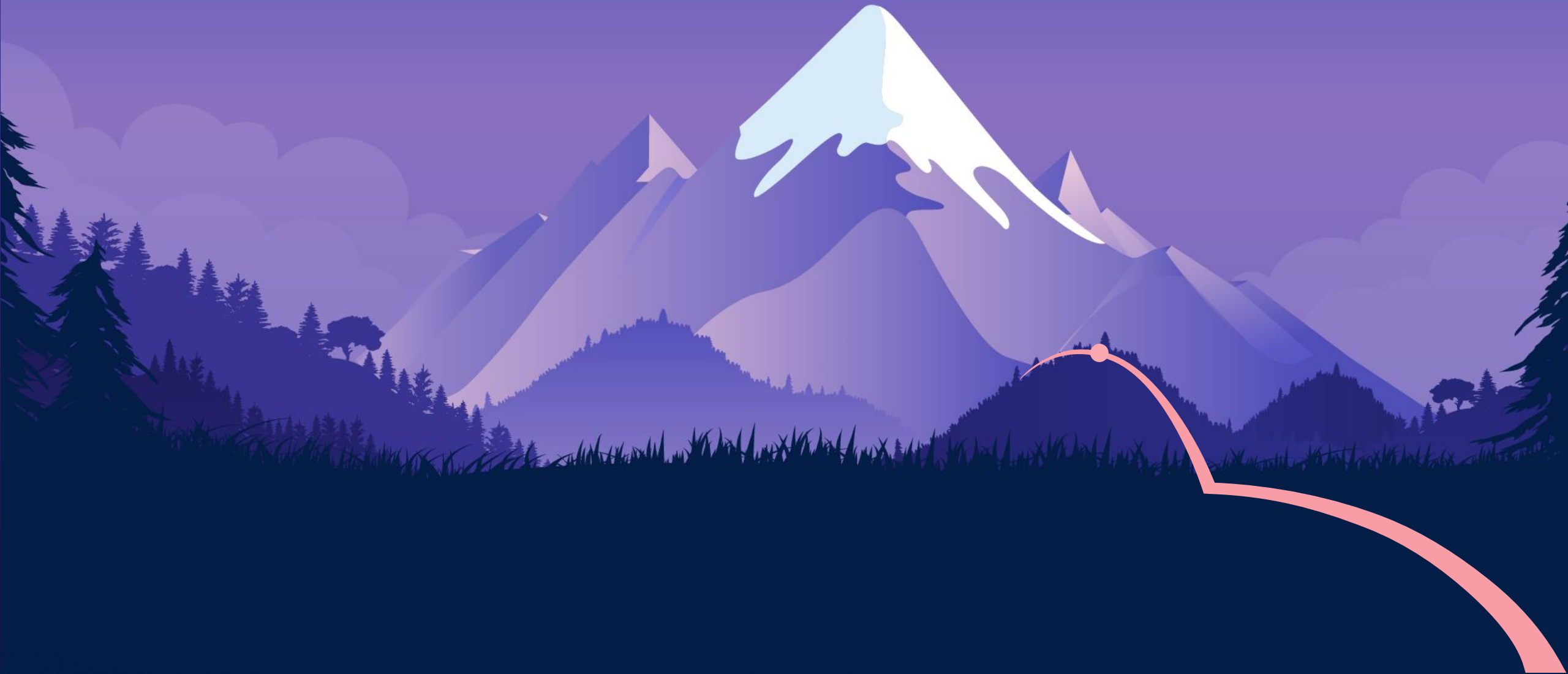

# Rolling into 2025 with v2025.3, what to expect

- **USCDI Version 3 Updates** – requires many functional changes throughout TouchWorks, heavy lifting!
- **Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)** – requires new feature functionalities / workflows to meet regulatory requirements
- **eCR Updates** – updates to trigger codes, adding more diagnosis for reporting
- **Call Out! Insight Measures** – a vendor requirement only reporting to the ONC on how you use TouchWorks. Data collection starts January 1, 2026.
  - Patient Accessing their EHI
  - FHIR Usages
  - Immunization Administrations

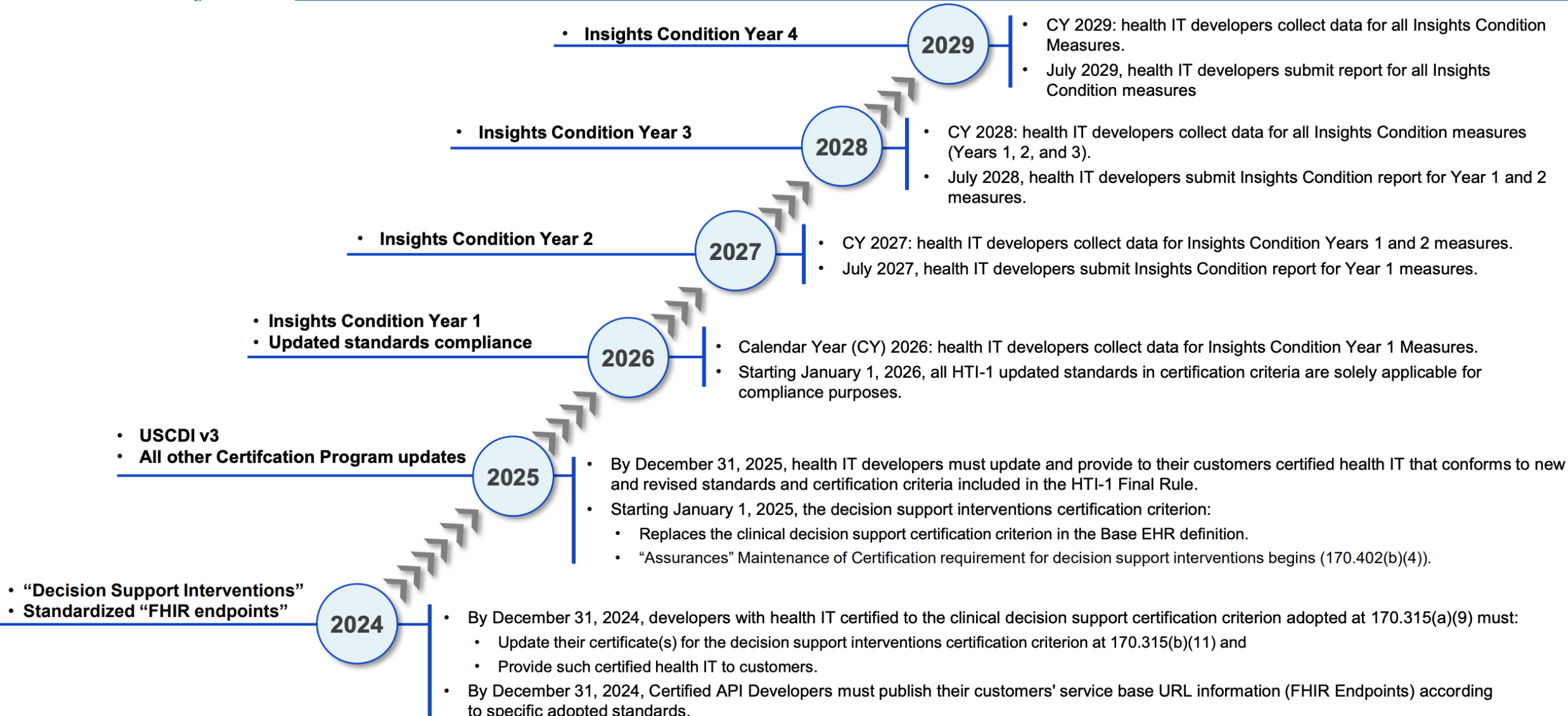


## Insight Measures

\*\*\*\*\*

Vendors must make every effort to upgrade clients to the certified version, which includes the Insights functionality, by December 31, 2025.... and every year thereafter.

ONC is aware, vendors can't force clients to upgrade but we are expected to actively encourage clients to upgrade prior to December 1, 2026.



# And then, more ... HTI-2 & HTI-3 released

- **HTI-2** Final rule focus on TEFCA
  - Defines key terms and ensuring compliance with the Information Blocking regulations when utilizing TEFCA mechanisms
  - Clarifies “TEFCA Manner Exception” which allows healthcare providers to exchange electronic health information solely through TEFCA without being considered information blocking if certain conditions are met
  - Incorporates provisions to support reliability, privacy and security of health information exchanged through the TEFCA framework
- **HTI-3** Final Rule creates a new Information Blocking “Protecting Care Access” exception



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
